

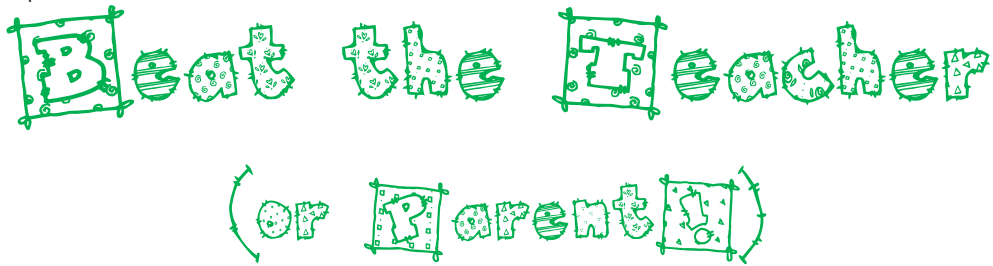
Great for 1 or more players



- Print “Sight Word Cards” and “Yuck” cards.
- Cut apart and mix together.
- Put all cards together in an “draw” pile.
- On your turn, draw the first card, read it and use it in a sentence.
 - If you read it correctly, it is yours to keep! If not, your partner can try to “steal” it by reading it correctly and using it in a sentence.
 - If you draw a “yuck” card, you have to put ALL of your cards back into the pile!
- The winner is the person with the most cards at the end of the game!

Shuffle and play again!

Great for 2 players



- Print “Sight Word Cards”.
 - Cut apart and mix together.
 - Put all cards together in an “draw” pile.
 - On your turn, draw the first card, read it.
 - Whoever reads it first gets to keep it.
 - The objective is to be the first person to correctly read the word.
 - If it is a tie, you can either put it in a “tie” pile, or put it on the bottom of the pile and try again!
 - The winner is the person with the most cards at the end of the game!
- Shuffle and play again!

Great for 1 or more players

Sight Word Sort

- Take your sight word cards out.
- Think of a way to sort them
 - Number of letters
 - Syllables
 - Beginning letter
 - Short vowels vs. long vowels
 - The possibilities are endless!
- Mix them up and try another way!

Great for 1 or more players

Say What?

- Put all of your sight words in a “draw pile”.
- Set a timer (2–3 minutes– you decide!)
- Draw three sight words.
- Try and use all three in a sentence (you can say more than one sentence if needed)
- Whatever words you are able to use in a sentence, you can keep.
- If you are unable to use a word, put it in a “discard” pile.
- When the timer goes off, count how many words you used.
- Record your score.
- Set the timer and try again!
